In the case of less than six fencers, categories can be pooled to one event.  A fencer without an official medical classification is not allowed to participate in an IWF competition. The placing of competitors within each category is strictly according to the decision of the official classifiers authorities who have examined and classified each competitor before the competition.		
<b>Medical</b>	Each fencer has to have an official international medical classification to participate in a World Cup competition.		
<b>Equipment</b>	According to the FIE and IWFC rules.  Latest submission of equipment latest 30min before the closing time.		
<b>Remarks</b>	The IWAS Registration fee must be paid directly to IWAS. This fee will be invoiced directly to the Nations/IWAS Members/Fencing Federations using the IWAS Managements system (IMS), or by IWAS invoice, as directed in the LOC Invitation/Information. Please note that your registration and entry to the competition is not complete until the IWAS Registration Fee has been received by IWAS.
