Remarks REQUIREMENTS

Candidates who wish to become accredited National Classifiers and undertake further training for International Accreditation, must have the following education/professional requirements:

- must be a certified health professional eg, Physiotherapists, Medical Practitioners, persons with sports science or medical/biological degrees

or

- must be persons with a technical knowledge of the sport who are no longer involved in an international level with a national team, eg coaches or retired international athletes.

Other interested persons may take the course for their own information or to become National Accredited classifiers only.

All participants have to sent their CV, a cover letter and a support letter from their national federation via email until the entry deadline to:

COURSE CONTENT

The course is designed to inform and guide trainees through the process and understanding of wheelchair Fencing classification. Practical sessions will demonstrate the techniques and approach taken. Participants will observe and take part in classification of athletes and observation of athletes during competition.

ASSESSMENT

Trainees will be assessed on their competency and understanding and will take a written examination as well as any oral questioning deemed necessary. Where appropriate trainees will be awarded a certificate for a National Accredited Classifier, or once the international standards and experience have been achieved, International Accredited Classifier Status will be awarded.

ENTRIES AND REGISTRATION

All entries for participants of the Classifier Seminar have to be done via the Ophardt system: https://iwas.ophardt.online/ DEADLINE: 13 AUGUST 2023

It is responsibility of the national federations to inform IWAS and the local Organizing Committee about any changes and keep all data up-to-date.

In exceptional situations:

- the registration of accommodation packages with the organizers and the registration of seminar participants in Ophardt system after 13 AUGUST 2023 may be considered by LOC or IWAS and may be accepted, but 20% penalty fee will be added to the regular accommodation fee, and a late entry fee will be charged.

Invoices for the Seminar Fee will be sent by IWAS office AFTER the seminar.

Invoices for Room Rates will be sent once you have completed the booking section and paid directly to the LOC using the bank details below.

PAYMENTS ROOM RATES

Room Rates must be paid directly to the local organizers.

The room rates will include accommodation and food in the official hotels, airport transfers to the hotels and between the hotels and the venue. Day rates start from the dinner on the day of arrival and continues until breakfast on the day of departure.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Any cancellation of ordered accommodation packages after 13 AUGUST 2023 but before 18 AUGUST 2023 will result in applying the cancellation fee: 75% of packages that have been ordered and cancelled.

Any cancellation of ordered accommodation packages after 19 AUGUST 2023 but before 26 AUGUST 2023 will result in applying the cancellation fee: 75% of package that have been ordered and cancelled.

Any cancellation of ordered accommodation packages after 27 AUGUST 2023 will result in applying the cancellation fee:

100% of package that have been ordered and cancelled.
