Peace and Friendship Stadium is one of the most important indoor sports facilities in Greece. It hosted sports at "Athens 2004" Olympic and Paralympic Games. The Peace and Friendship Stadium is located in the Neo Faliro area of Piraeus municipality, on the coastal Poseidonos Avenue, and at the end of the Kifissou Avenue. It is 2 km away from the port of Piraeus. It is located on a major transportation hub, next to the Faliro metro station on Athens Metro Line 1, and the SEF tram stop, the terminus of Athens Tram.

COURSE INFORMATION:

The course is aimed at training wheelchair fencing coaches, athletes and officials with the aim of promoting the development of the sport in their countries.

To participate in the course, candidates registered by their National Federations or National Paralympic Committees must have:

-Experience as fencing or wheelchair fencing coaches.

-Or be an athlete or official with experience in fencing or wheelchair fencing.

The course will be held in foil, epee and sabre.

The course will be held in English.

Candidates have to bring:

- Fencing equipment (foil, sabre, epee)

- Instructor / Coaches Jacket

- Fencing Mask(s) / Glove(s)

- Training outfit

- Business casual attire

EDUCATIONAL AND GUIDED TOUR PROGRAM

> Olympia

On Wednesday, November 1st, the seminar participants will visit Ancient Olympia, where they will be guided to the archaeological site, the ancient stadium and the museum. A unique life experiences!

> Sparta

On Thursday, November 2nd, the seminar participants will visit Sparta and will have the opportunity





to visit the archaeological site and attend interesting pedagogical theoretical courses from the professors at the Peloponnese University.

Transportation to Olympia and Sparta as well as accommodation in Sparta for one night (November 1st) will be covered by the LOC in a hotel in double rooms.

ATHLETES AND TRAINING CAMP

During the coaching course, each participating coach can be accompanied, if they wish, by 1 wheelchair fencing athlete (if space permits we can extend to 2) who can take advantage of the experience of the course and train.

On the last day of the course, an IWAS Wheelchair Fencing Development Competition will be held, where athletes will take part and may be classified.

The Entry Fee for the athlete is 150 Euro per athlete.

Athletes are also responsible for their own accommodations, flights etc.
