Deadline: 15 February 2023 noon (CET)

Registration of the whole team (accreditations, accommodation packages, all travel details etc.) has to be done also by mail to Marine EYMERET (LOC) (meymeret@spartner-agency.com), Julie DUCOS (LOC) (j.ducos@wpaparis23.com) and Laura GROSSIORD (LOC) (l.grossiord@wpaparis23.com) by sending the **official entry forms**.

DEADLINE: 2 February 2024

The data from Ophardt system and the entry form must be consistent and current. It is responsibility of national federations to inform LOC **AND** IWAS about any changes and keep all data up-to-date.

- Packages (accommodation, transport, catering) must be registered with the organisers **before 2 February 2024**.
- If you validate your packages **between 3 and 9 February**, a penalty of 20% on your package will be applied.
- No package requests will be accepted **after 9 February 2024**.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Any cancellation of ordered accommodation packages after the packages proforma invoice is edited and sent to the NPC will result in applying a **100% cancellation fee**.

Please note: After the closing deadline for entries, there can be no further withdrawal of a name except in any case of force majeure duly justified (see rulebook o.56.3).

PAYMENTS FOR ACCREDITATION AND ROOM RATES

Accreditation Rate and Room Rates must be **paid directly to the local organizers**.

- The accreditation rate will allow competition accreditation only. Airport transfers, travel to venue, accommodation and food is not included.
- The room rates will include accommodation and food in the official hotels, airport transfers to the hotels and between the hotels and the venue. Day rates start from the dinner on the day of arrival and continues until breakfast on the day of departure.

All members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidents, injuries or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility or financial loss or any other responsibility incurred by any of the participants whatsoever.

The **World Abilitysport Registration Fee** (50 GBP per person), a possible **Late Entry Surcharge** (150 GBP per person after the entry deadline and until 3 days before the competition, 250 GBP until the head of delegation meeting), the **fine for missing referees** (1.500 GBP per missing referee before and 2.000 GBP after the entry deadline) and possible other fines must be paid



directly to World Abilitysport WF.

Please note that all fees and penalties payable to WF will be invoiced **AFTER THE COMPETITION**.
